SMC was founded by Kyuujiro Okuma, the 1st school principal in 1956. Since then, SMC as a training institution graduated many Massage·Shiatsu, Acupuncture and Moxibustion practitioners.

Department of Judo Therapy and Acupuncture was opened in 2000. And Department of Occupational Therapy and Physical Therapy was opened in 1997 the school graduated professional therapists with the Western medical training.

And Department of Nursing were opened in 2006 and Department of Sports Medicine were opened in 2009. Now SMC has 7 Departments and has become an integrative medical college.

● A Chronological 50 Years' History

1956	Kagawa Shiatsu School founded at Imajin, Takamatsu City.
1958	The Ministry of the Health, Labor and Social Welfare granted certification as a training school for Anma, Massage and Shiatsu practitioners.
1960	The Ministry of the Health, Labor and Social Welfare granted certification as a school for Acupuncture Moxibustion practitioners. School was renamed as Kagawa Prefectural Shiatsu·Acupuncture and Moxibustion Training College.
1971	School moved to Fujitsuka campus in Takamatsu city.
1976	Kagawa Prefecture's permit as Technical and Medical College.
1979	School renamed as Shikoku Acupuncture College.
1992	School moved to Utazu Campus in Ayauta Gun.
1994	Kagawa Prefecture governor's permit as school corporate body Ooasa College.
1997	Department of Occupational Therapy and Physical Therapy opened.
2000	Acupuncture, Moxibustion and Judo Therapy Department opened.
2006	School of Medical College(Oriental Medicine and Judo Therapy) and Department of Occupational and Physical Therapy merged as Shikoku Medical College.
2007	Department of Nursing Opened.
2009	Department of Sports Medicine Opened.
